From the beginning, people noticed Amy Lynn's unique signature in her paintings. Born in Nebraska, she was an artist at a very young age, as she was constantly drawing and painting. Lynn attended the University of Nebraska, where she earned her BFA in painting and then moved to Minneapolis to work as an artist. She painted more than 300 commissions, but as her real life began to merge with her artistic life, the world in her art grew larger. Lynn now lives in Los Angeles, where she has become a favorite among designers. She was recently asked to do a series of paintings for the New Otani Hotel, and two of her pieces will be featured on the FOX hit TV reality show, "Hell's Kitchen."
